P R O C E E D I N G S

MR. CHILK: Two affirmations. One, Secy 79.485, 484 dealing with delegation of authority of the director of NMSS to improve actions on Public Law 95.604. The Commission unanimously approved permission to delegate the authority and I would ask you to affirm.

(Series of ayes.)

MR. CHILK: The other is 79-514, proposed amendments to CFR part 2 concerning discipline in an adjudicatory proceedings. The Commission unanimously approved this subject to the following modifications. Section 2713(c)(1) was to be revised by adding the words "reprimand and censure, or" and that was done unanimously by the Commission.

Section 2713(c)(3) was revised, first by adding a sentence, and that was by vote of 3 to 2 with Commissioners Gilinsky and Bradford dissenting.

There was also some additional language to be added in Section 2713(c)(3) dealing with notification to the state bars where suspensions are involved, and that was done unanimously by the Commission. Commissioner Bradford would have preferred to add a section, general suspension of appearance, and that was not supported by the majority of the Commission. I would ask you to affirm your votes.
