Dear Dr. Pruss:

I am responding to your March 21, 1997, letter returning annual fee Invoice AM2722-97 and informing the NRC that Clarion Pharmaceuticals, Inc., will not be renewing Materials License 48-26624-01.

Footnote 1 of 10 CFR 171.16 provides that the annual fee is waived when a license is terminated prior to October 1 of each fiscal year. The NRC has exempted from the FY 1997 annual fee those licensees, and holders of certificates, registrations, and approvals who either filed for termination of their licenses or approvals or filed for possession only/storage only licenses prior to October 1, 1996, and were capable of permanently ceasing licensed activities entirely by September 30, 1996.

Annual fees are assessed based on whether a licensee holds a valid NRC license that authorizes possession and use of radioactive material. Whether or not a licensee is actually conducting operations using the material is a matter of licensee discretion. An amendment request filed after October 1 of each fiscal year to cancel a license does not cancel the annual fee invoice. Your March 21, 1997, request was not timely filed to avoid the FY 1997 annual fee. However, NRC regulations provide that materials licensees who filed for termination between October 1 and March 31 are assessed one-half of the annual fee. Accordingly, Invoice AM2722-97 has been revised to reflect 50 percent and is enclosed.

Enclosed is NRC Form 526, Certification of Small Entity Status, for your possible use. If you determine Clarion Pharmaceuticals, Inc., meets NRC small entity size standards and so certify by completing and returning the NRC Form 526 for FY 1997, the annual fee would be reduced to 50 percent of the applicable small entity fee.

License 48-26624-01 was terminated April 11, 1997, based on your March 21, 1997, request. If you have any further questions, please contact Shirley Crutchfield on 301-415-6097.
