Gentlemen:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 03 to your NRC License No. 34-12736-02 in accordance with your request.

Please note that we have approved most of your requests and changes as described in letter dated October 30, 1986 and June 26, 1987 with the following exceptions:

1. We have not approved Messrs. Lefke or Rybak to be appointed as deputy RSO or designated as RSO. As defined by you, the deputy RSO or designated RSO can be assigned all the duties and responsibilities of the RSO. As such these individuals must meet the minimum qualifications required for that position. These individuals have not demonstrated sufficient training and experience in radiation safety to assure us they can adequately carry out the functions of the RSO.
2. We have not authorized incineration of radioactive material (other than as allowed by 10 CFR 20.306) at this time. In order to receive this authorization you must submit the additional information requested by Dr. Mallett in his letter dated February 15, 1984. He requested you to provide the information requested in Items 1 and 4 of the enclosed "Incineration Guidelines For Materials Licensees". In addition, when you apply for approval of the new incinerator, please provide all of the information requested in the guidelines.

Please review your license carefully to assure that you understand and are in compliance with the terms and conditions contained therein. If you have questions, please contact our office at (312) 790-5625.
