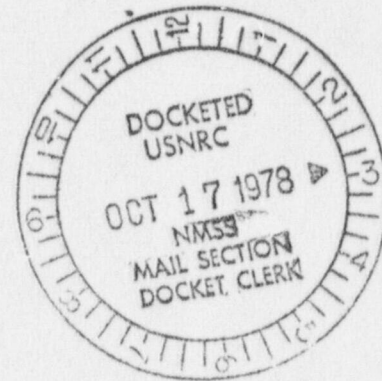

After talking to Dr. Cooperstein on the telephone requesting an appointment to discuss our SML application, I felt it would be helpful to forward an agenda on items Cliffs would like to discuss.

- Item 1 - Discuss the construction definition, can some construction; i.e., roads, buildings, well patterns be completed while SML is in review process. Reason for question is winter and spring weather constraints.
- Item 2 - Define excursion, baseline, monitor wells, etc.
- Item 3 - Radiation safety program on research basis, can Cliffs develop as program goes on in a research mode.
- Item 4 - Define restoration and discuss restoration levels (NH<sub>4</sub>).
- Item 5 - Ability to change oxidants later in test.
- Item 6 - Discuss NRC-SML procedures for changing equipment in plant and/or design.
- Item 7 - Permit/License Process Timing in relation to review.
- Item 8 - General Discussion of Process.
- Item 9 - Review of North Rolling Pin Restoration.
