Dear Mr. Bordenick:

This letter is to request that you change the names of the officials of the California Department of Parks and Recreation who are the named parties in the Department's intervention in the proceeding, "In the Matter of San Diego Gas and Electric Sun Desert Nuclear Plant Units Number 1 and 2", case numbers 50-582 and 50-583.

The new director of the Department of Parks and Recreation is Russell Cahill, replacing Herbert Rhodes. The duties of the State Historic Preservation Officer have been delegated to Knox Mellon, Ph.D., by the Director of Parks and Recreation. Accordingly, we request that you substitute the names of Russell Cahill and Knox Mellon for Herbert Rhodes, who was previously both the Director of the Department of Parks and Recreation and the State Historic Preservation Officer.

We understand that the San Diego Gas and Electric Company has announced that it is withdrawing its application for a license for the Sun Desert power plant but that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission planned to complete the environmental impact statement for this site before suspending further action.

We request that you inform us if any further actions are scheduled for this proceeding.
