Dear Mr. Donoghue:


I hereby request personal access to reports submitted to E.J. Brunner, chief of the Reactor Operations and Nuclear Support Branch, as described by him in a letter on or about June 30, 1978 requesting "base line evaluation for RIP" in which he asks NRC officials to provide by July 24, 1978 a "brief, -- 'gut feeling' evaluation for the licensees and facilities listed below of their performance in the area of your inspection responsibility. The basis for this evaluation should be the specific licensee's performance compared to all other licensees and facilities in Region 1. Your evaluation will be incorporated into an 'unofficial,' overall evaluation of the licensee and facility to be utilized by the regional office as base line information for the revised inspection program." (See enclosure) Please provide the reports given Mr. Brunner and the "unofficial, overall evaluation of the licensee and facility" he describes for the Northeast Nuclear Energy Company (Northeast Utilities) for the Millstone Point plants One and Two in Waterford, Conn., including reports for all areas listed in the Brunner memorandum: Overall management, quality assurance, personnel training, procedures, refueling and LRTs, fire protection and part 21, ISI, radiation protection and environmental. I request this information under 5 U.S.C. 552 et seq., the Freedom of Information Act.

If you agree to this request in whole or in part, please supply me with the information if search and copy fees do not exceed a total of \$100. If it will exceed \$100, please inform me of the cost.

If any part of this request is denied, please inform me of your appeal procedures. I will consider my request denied if I have no communication from you within 10 working days of receipt of this letter.

Please be put on notice that I consider your refusal to release the information to be arbitrary and capricious as defined in the act. Please send the documents to me at the above address. I thank you for your attention to this matter.


