Gentlemen:

You submitted supplemental information regarding Proposed Change No. 125 with your letter of November 7, 1975, and requested that Attachment A be considered to contain proprietary information and requested that it be withheld from public disclosure. You identified Attachment B to be a non-proprietary version of Attachment A and did not request that it be withheld from public disclosure.

The reason for withholding the information was stated to be that it reveals certain distinguishing aspects of fuel design where prevention of its use by any of Exxon Nuclear's competitors without license from Exxon Nuclear constitutes a competitive economic advantage over other companies. Its use by a competitor would reduce his expenditure or resources or improve his competitive position in the design and manufacture of a similar product.

We have examined the subject information and pursuant to Section 2.790(b) of 10 CFR Part 2, have approved your request.

Accordingly, pursuant to Section 2.790(b) of 10 CFR Part 2, we are withholding Attachment A to your letter of November 7, 1975, from public inspection. Withholding from public inspection shall not affect the right, if any, of persons properly and directly concerned to inspect the documents.
