6.0 INTERNAL INSPECTION PROGRAM

6.1 Management Inspection of Operation

- A. On a quarterly basis and at the direction of the Director Quality Assurance Maintenance & Engineering, inspections of radiographic sites are conducted using field radiography, internal inspection checklist, in compliance with N.R.C. 10 CFR 34.11D.
- B. At the conclusion of each such inspection as in (A) above, a written report is submitted to the Director Quality Assurance Maintenance & Engineering by the RSO noting any discrepancies in the inspection and also commenting on any other aspect of radiation safety observed. The RSO maintains such reports on file (File No. IRS-9).

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2.5 Duties and Responsibilities of Inspectors

- A. Inspectors perform the functions of Radiographer or Radiographer's Assistant as outlined in this manual when directed to do so by the RSO or Foremen Aircraft Inspection.
- B. Radiographer supervises Assistant Radiographer when surveying to verify that sealed source has been returned to its shielded container.

2.6 Duties and Responsibilities of the Medical Department

- A. The designated Medical Department conducts both blood tests and or unscheduled physical exams of personnel at the request of the RSO.
- B. Employees who have received significant amounts of radiation and remain in the employ of the company must have the approval of the designated Medical Department before again being allowed to handle sources of radiation.
- C. When, in the opinion of the designated Medical Department, continued exposure to radiation is likely to injure an employee's health, that employee is removed from the status of Radiographer or Radiographer's Assistant by the RSO.

2.7 Delegation of Authority

- A. The Superintendant Aircraft inspection (RSO) may delegate any of his duties and responsibilities to the Foremen, Aircraft Inspection. Such delegations must be made in writing and kept on file by the RSO.
