We have audited, in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards, the consolidated financial statements of Mobil Corporation for the year ended December 31, 1990, and have issued our report thereon dated March 1, 1991.

As you requested, we have read the letter dated August 15, 1991 from Lucio A. Noto, Chief Financial Officer of Mobil Corporation, submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission in support of the use of the financial test, as specified in 10 CFR Part 30, to demonstrate financial assurance for the cost of decommissioning Mobil Oil Corporation's licensed nuclear facility at Pennington, New Jersey. We have compared to the independently audited consolidated financial statements of Mobil Corporation for the year ended December 31, 1990, the data set forth in the letter under the caption "Financial Test (Alternative II)" indicated as being derived from such independently audited consolidated financial statements for the year ended December 31, 1990. In connection with this comparison, no matters came to our attention that caused us to believe that the specified data set forth in the letter under the caption "Financial Test (Alternative II)" should be adjusted.

This report is solely to assist you in complying with the reporting requirements associated with the financial test, as specified in 10 CFR Part 30, to demonstrate financial assurance for the cost of decommissioning Mobil Oil Corporation's licensed nuclear facility at Pennington, New Jersey, and should not be referred to or used for any other purpose.

PARENT COMPANY GUARANTEE

Guarantee made this 15th day of August 1991 by Mobil Corporation, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Delaware, herein referred to as "guarantor" to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), on behalf of our subsidiary, Mobil Oil Corporation of 3225 Gallows Road, Fairfax, VA 22037-0001.

Recitals

1. The guarantor has full authority and capacity to enter into this guarantee under its bylaws, articles of incorporation, and the laws of the State of Delaware, its State of incorporation. Guarantor has approval from its Board of Directors to enter into this guarantee.
2. This guarantee is being issued to comply with regulations issued by the NRC, an agency of the U.S. Government, pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974. NRC has promulgated regulations in Title 10, Chapter 1 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 30 which require that a holder of, or an applicant for, a materials license issued pursuant to 10 CFR Part 30 provide assurance that funds will be available when needed for required decommissioning activities.
3. The guarantee is issued to provide financial assurance for decommissioning activities for Mobil Oil Corporation's Mobil Environmental and Health Sciences Laboratory in Pennington, New Jersey as required by 10 CFR Part 30, the prescribed amount for which is \$150,000.
4. The guarantor meets or exceeds the following financial test criteria under part (a) and agrees to comply with all notification requirements as specified in 10 CFR Part 30.

The guarantor shall meet one of the following two financial tests:

- (a) (i) A current rating of its most recent bond issuance of AAA, AA, A or BBB as issued by Standard and Poor's or Aaa, Aa, A or Baa as rated by Moody's; and
- (ii) Tangible net worth is at least \$10 million and at least six times the current decommissioning cost estimate (or prescribed amount if a certification is used); and
- (iii) Assets located in the United States amounting to at least 90 percent of its total assets or at

or

least six times the current decommissioning cost (or prescribed amount if certification is used).

- (b) (i) Net working capital and tangible net worth each at least six times the current decommissioning cost estimates (or prescribed amount if certification is used); and
 - (ii) Assets located in the United States amounting to at least 90 percent of its total assets or at least six times the amount of the current decommissioning cost estimates (or prescribed amount if certification is used); and
 - (iii) Meets two of the following three ratios: a ratio of total liabilities to net worth less than 2.0; a ratio of the sum of net income plus depreciation, depletion, and amortization to total liabilities that is greater than 0.1; and a ratio of current assets to current liabilities that is greater than 1.5; and
 - (iv) Tangible net worth of at least \$10 million.
5. The guarantor has majority control of the voting stock for the following licensee covered by this guarantee.

6. Decommissioning activities as used below refers to the activities required by 10 CFR Part 30 for decommissioning of the facility identified above.
7. For value received from Mobil Oil Corporation and pursuant to the authority conferred upon the guarantor by the unanimous resolution of its directors, a certified copy of which is attached, the guarantor guarantees to the NRC that if the licensee fails to perform the required decommissioning activities, as required by License No. 29-19737-01, the guarantor shall
- (a) carry out the required activities, or
 - (b) set up a trust fund in favor of the above identified beneficiary in the amount of these current cost estimates for these activities.
8. The guarantor agrees to submit revised financial statements, financial test data, and a special auditor's report annually within 90 days of the close of the parent guarantor's fiscal year.

9. The guarantor agrees that if, at the end of any fiscal year before termination of this guarantee, it fails to meet the financial test criteria, the licensee shall send within 90 days of the end of the fiscal year, by certified mail, notice to the NRC that the licensee intends to provide alternative financial assurance as specified in 10 CFR Part 30. Within 120 days after the end of the fiscal year, the guarantor shall establish such financial assurance if Mobil Oil Corporation has not done so.
10. The guarantor also agrees to notify the beneficiary promptly if the ownership of the licensee or the parent firm is transferred and to maintain this guarantee until the new parent firm or the licensee provides alternative financial assurance acceptable to the beneficiary.
11. The guarantor agrees that within 30 days after it determines that it no longer meets the financial test criteria or it is disallowed from continuing as a guarantor for the facility under License No. 29-19737-01, it shall establish an alternative financial assurance as specified in 10 CFR Part 30, in the name of Mobil Oil Corporation, unless Mobil Oil Corporation has done so.
12. The guarantor as well as its successors and assigns agree to remain bound jointly and severally under this guarantee notwithstanding any or all of the following: Amendment or modification of license or NRC approved decommissioning funding plan for that facility, the extension or reduction of the time of performance of required activities, or any other modification or alteration of an obligation of the licensee pursuant to 10 CFR Part 30.
13. The guarantor agrees that all bound parties shall be jointly and severally liable for all litigation costs incurred by the beneficiary, NRC, in any successful effort to enforce the agreement against the guarantor.
14. The guarantor agrees to remain bound under this guarantee for as long as Mobil Oil Corporation must comply with applicable financial assurance requirements of 10 CFR Part 30, for the previously listed facility, except that the guarantor may cancel this guarantee by sending notice by certified mail to the NRC, and to Mobil Oil Corporation, such cancellation to become effective no earlier than 120 days after receipt of such notice by both the NRC and Mobil Oil Corporation as evidenced by the return receipts.
15. The guarantor agrees that if Mobil Oil Corporation fails to provide alternative financial assurance as specified in 10 CFR Part 30, as applicable, and obtain written approval of such assurance from the NRC within 90 days after a notice of


cancellation by the guarantor is received by both the NRC and Mobil Oil Corporation from the guarantor, the guarantor shall provide such alternative financial assurance in the name of Mobil Oil Corporation or make full payment under the guarantee.

16. The guarantor expressly waives notice of acceptance of this guarantee by the NRC or by Mobil Oil Corporation. The guarantor also expressly waives notice of amendments or modification of the decommissioning requirements and of amendments or modification of the license.
17. If the guarantor files financial reports with the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission, then it shall promptly submit them to the NRC during each year in which this guarantee is in effect.



<p>Summary: Asked her about some of the instrumentation used in the final status survey. She indicated that the contractor would be more familiar with those questions.</p> <p>The inspector discussed the results of the final status survey with David Durkee, the contractor. The contractor answered questions about the efficiency of the liquid scintillation counter used for the final status survey. He explained the channels used on the LS counter, and cleared up some confusion about the efficiencies assigned to some of the wipe results. I explained to the contractor that on some occasions, the results listed on the final status survey seemed to indicate that the efficiency was greater than 100% in the tritium channel. The contractor explained to me that some of the data from the C-14 channel were leaking into the tritium channel. On the specific items that he was questioned, he explained to the inspector that the wipes in question were recounted anyway.</p> <p>All questions about the counting results were answered.</p> <p>In addition, the inspector informed Lynn Fanelli that the Region is required to return any original financial assurance documents once the license is terminated. She indicated that she did not mind. I read the list of documents that are currently in our files. We agreed to meet on December 17, 1996.</p> <p>No remaining issues.</p>

Radiological status surveys have been completed in support of the decommissioning of Building 17, Stonybrook Laboratories, Inc. and in preparation for the sale of Mobil Technical Center (MTC), Princeton, NJ. Based on the attached survey reports prepared by Radiation Safety Associates, Inc., Hebron, CT, no potential areas of concern remain due to past use of radioactive materials at Stonybrook Laboratories. Therefore, we are submitting *NRC Form 314* to formally request license termination and free release of the facility for unrestricted use.


- **Building 17 - Stonybrook Laboratories**. This is the only building at MTC still covered under a Nuclear Regulatory Commission license (#29-19737-01). As indicated in the report titled, "*Final Status Survey Report for Decommissioning Stonybrook Laboratories, Inc. Building 17*," this facility has been surveyed and remediated as necessary to meet NRC criteria for release for unrestricted use. Copies of the actual survey data (*Volumes I - IV*) are also enclosed for your information and review.

All radioactive waste generated during decommissioning has been shipped off-site for disposal under the direction of Ecology Services, Inc., Columbia, MD. The former waste storage area and one questionable sink area were resurveyed on July 23, 1996. All areas were found to be below acceptable release criteria. Results are contained in the attached *July 23, 1996, Stonybrook Laboratories, Building 17, Radiation Survey Results* report.

To facilitate the sale of the Mobil Technical Center property, this report and supporting data is being submitted to your attention in support of license termination and free release of the facility. 
