CHAIRMAN HENDRIE: Sam, do we have something?

MR. CHILK: We have tentatively scheduled this morning an affirmation of the Offshore Power Systems order.

Shortly before the meeting started, I was apprised of a change in the order recommended by Commissioner Bradford. That modification has not been agreed to by all of you, and Commissioner Bradford has requested that the Offshore Power Systems order not be affirmed this morning.

In accordance with our procedures as I understand them to be, the Commission recently approved, I will schedule this with your permission, for discussion session early next week, probably on Monday immediately after the briefing that is already scheduled?

COMMISSIONER KENNEDY: When?

MR. CHILK: Monday, this coming Monday.

COMMISSIONER KENNEDY: I will tell you after I consider my schedule whether I will be present.

MR. CHILK: Or we can schedule at a time that is convenient. I am just saying there is a meeting on Monday. It looks as if the calendars are free. With your concurrence I will work that out.

Okay. That takes care of the affirmation item.
