Retraction of Reported Discharge to the Delaware River**

Dear Sir/Madam:

PSEG Nuclear LLC (PSEG) is herein submitting additional information in order to rescind and retract the May 15, 2020 notification of a discharge of less than one pint of fish oil to the Delaware River. The discharge was reported to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) hotline at 0947 hours and assigned case number 20-05-15-0948-09 by Operator #93.

PSEG has since determined that fish oil, a non-petroleum based material, is not a NJ "hazardous substance" and therefore is not a discharge under the Discharge Prevention, Containment and Countermeasure (DPCC) rules. Since this is not a discharge, a 30-day discharge confirmation report is also not required. The discharge was however reported to the National Response Center / USCG under the Federal SPCC rule.
