The national, so-called "low-level" radioactive waste dump at Waste Control Specialists, LLC (WCS) in extreme west Texas, immediately upon the New Mexico state border near the largely Hispanic community of Eunice, NM, already threatens the Ogallala Aquifer with radioactive contamination over time. The Ogallala is the source of vital drinking and irrigation water for eight states on the High Plains. This WCS/ISP CISF (Interim Storage Partners Consolidated Interim Storage Facility) for highly radioactive irradiated nuclear fuel, and Greater-Than-Class-C (GTCC) "low-level" radioactive wastes, would add to the high risk that hazardous radioactive waste would contaminate the vital, unreplaceable Ogallala, over time.
