RENEWED FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE NPF-30
CONSOLIDATED NPDES DISCHARGE PERMIT REAPPLICATION**

In accordance with Callaway Plant Operating License NPF-30, Appendix B, Section 3.2, Union Electric Company (Ameren Missouri) hereby submits the enclosed National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Missouri State Operating Permit Reapplication for the Callaway Plant (MO-0098001). The NPDES Operating Permit Reapplication was submitted to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (DNR) on December 20, 2019. Also enclosed is additional supplemental information which was provided to Missouri DNR as part of this reapplication.

The NPDES permit reapplication included a change to state that plant personnel may operate Cooling Tower Bypass with the continuous biocide system in service. Compliance with the permit will be verified using an additional approved sample point, which was requested in the permit reapplication. Evidence of acceptability is shown in the enclosed report.

Based on when the enclosed NPDES permit reapplication was submitted to the State, it is acknowledged that this letter for reporting the permit reapplication is not being submitted in a timely manner and not in conformance with the intent of Section 3.2 of Appendix B, which specifies that a copy of a renewal application shall be provided to the NRC "at the same time the application is submitted to the permitting agency." The delay in providing a copy of the December 20, 2019 permit reapplication is being addressed in the plant's corrective action program.
