40 years of "temporary storage" is inappropriately short, given Holtec's own admission in its license application to NRC that "interim storage" could persist for 120 years; in response to a Request for Information from DOE, Holtec admitted a CISF could operate for 300 years; and in NRC's own 2014 Continued Storage of Spent Nuclear Fuel Rule and Generic EIS, the agency acknowledged away-from-reactor ISFSIs (Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installations) could go on INDEFINITELY!!

Failed containers could release large amounts of hazardous radioactivity and harm generations of people and animals.

We need much better storage than proposed.
