SUBJECT: TERMINATION AMENDMENT NO. 5 TO CIMA HEART INSTITUTE AND TESTING CENTER, NRC LICENSE NO. 21-32508-01

Dear Ms. Breining:

In NRC Form 314 dated April 3, 2020, CIMA Heart Institute and Testing Center (you) contacted the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and indicated that you wished to terminate NRC License No. 21-32508-01. In your correspondence, you submitted information confirming that all residual licensed material from CIMA Heart Institute and Testing Center had been removed from your Lansing, Michigan, location of use, listed on the referenced license – such that any remaining residual radioactivity is within the limits of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* Part 20, Subpart E, and is ALARA. Your letter is available electronically from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at accession number ML20101H632. The NRC's ADAMS is accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.

Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from the facilities located at CIMA Heart Institute and Testing Center, 3960 Patient Care Dr., Ste. 109, Lansing, Michigan and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria. Based on these conclusions no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material are required. Your facilities are suitable for unrestricted use and NRC license number 21-32508-01 is hereby terminated. However, as discussed via e-mail, please note that the documentation confirming the transfer of your sealed sources to Hot Shots Pharmacy is still needed, to close our file for your license.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required, since this action is categorically excluded under Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) Section 51.22(c).
