This is in reference to your letter dated May 26, 2020, requesting to amend NRC License No. 06-06941-01. We have received and reviewed the documents send on July 10, 2020 and July 13, 2020. We have two remaining questions. In order to continue our review, please provide the following additional information:

1. Please provide a copy of the Arizona permit or license for the University of Arizona Cancer Center with Youbok Kim, PhD, listed as an AMP. If this is a broad scope license please provide sufficient documentation showing Dr. Kim was approved by the radiation safety committee to work as an AMP.
2. On the "Norwalk HDR-IVRT Topic" check list please list the **full** names of the trainers and the dates each portion of training was conducted. Additionally, please list the location of the training.

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Please reply to my attention at Tara.Weidner@nrc.gov, include the *Mail Control No. 621045* in your response

In order to continue prompt review of your application, we request that you submit your response within 20 calendar days from the date of this email.
