IMPORTS

This route request is for shipment of irradiated reactor fuel being returned to General Electric Company, Pleasanton, California after irradiations and testing in Europe.

General Electric is expecting two (2) spent fuel import shipments between July, 1984 and December, 1984. Security for these shipments will be according to the regulatory requirements of 10 CFR 73.37 relative to transit through heavily populated areas and as required while shipments are stationed at U. S. ports.

We are requesting that the route be approved for a period of one year.

As always, General Electric will provide details of shipment to your office prior to each shipment.
