Dear ,

To the NRC Commissioners, Staff, VLLW Docket NRC-2020-0065, and Members of Congress:

Since NRC's primary mission is to protect public health and safety, this proposal to dispose of nuclear waste in landfills and generic hazardous waste sites is totally contrary to that mission. Even Very Low-level Waste is hazardous. In addition, NRC has the intention of not requiring notification of the public prior to such disposals. Over time, this radioactive residue could filter down to underground fresh water aquifers, rendering them toxic and resulting in the loss of safe drinking water.

Keep radioactive waste under control--Do NOT send it to regular or hazardous waste sites. Rescind the VLLW proposal and continue requiring all handlers of nuclear waste to have a specific radioactive license, not "specific exemptions."
