Dear Sir or Madam,

Appendix C to Title 10 CFR Part 20, Quantities of Licensed Material Requiring Labeling, lists individual values for depleted uranium isotopes such as U-234, U-235 and U-238.

When the unity rule is used for these radionuclides to determine a quantity corresponding to a reporting value in 10 CFR 20.2201, it seems contradictory that uranyl acetate, for example, which is discussed in NUREG-1556, Vol. 7 Rev.1 as being possessed under General License, could have such a small quantity reportable as lost. Is there an exception for DU for the reporting quantity in 20.2201?
