Dear Mr. Rivera:

By letters dated April 2, 2020, and July 6, 2020, Beaumont Michigan Heart Group submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) a request for consent to license transfer of NRC Materials License No. 21-26392-01. Specifically, the licensee informed the NRC that the professional agreement between Beaumont Health System and Michigan Heart Group, P.C. will expire on October 31, 2020. As a result, effective November 1, 2020, Michigan Heart Group, P.C. will assume direct control of License No. 21-26392-01. The letters are available electronically from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at Accession Nos. ML20135H163 and ML20210M190. Further, we understand that this transfer will not result in any changes to personnel, licensed facilities, or the radiation safety program.

Based on the above understandings and as more fully detailed in the enclosed NRC staff's Safety Evaluation Report which documents the NRC staff's review of the request, we have no objection to the proposed transfer. Please note that you will need to notify us promptly, in writing, after the transaction has been finalized and include a signed copy of the agreement confirming completion of the transaction. With this information, we can issue an amendment to the NRC license to reflect the transaction and any other changes to the license. Please address the request to my attention.

The NRC's Safety Culture Policy Statement became effective in June 2011.
