In accordance with 10 CFR 72.212, "Conditions of general license issued under §72.210," paragraph (b)(2), Exelon Generation Company, LLC (EGC) is registering, with the NRC, the use of a casks under the general license to store spent fuel at Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station. These casks were placed into service with stored spent fuel on July 24, 2020 and August 5, 2020 respectively. This registration is required to be submitted within 30 days. Accordingly, this submittal is due by August 24, 2020.


