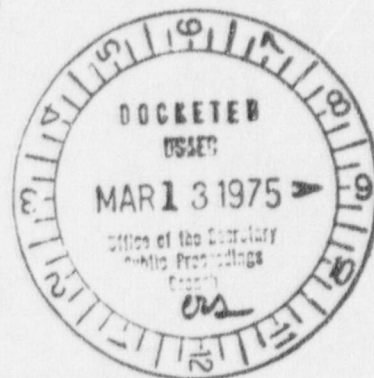

MOTHERS FOR PEACE MOTION OF FEBRUARY 3, 1975
CONCERNING CONFERENCES BETWEEN PGandE
AND THE NRC REGULATORY STAFF

As stated in the Board's Order of February 20, 1975,
the Board was aware that the question concerning the
February 7, 1975 meeting was moot but recognized that the
motion would be relevant to future meetings between PGandE
and Staff.

The Board received a response from PGandE dated
February 28, 1975 and from the NRC Regulatory Staff dated
March 7, 1975. The parties are in agreement for the
reasons stated that such meetings are proper and necessary
for a full development of the parties' responsibilities and
that any substantive information will be reflected in their
published documents pertaining to the proceeding. The


