Dear Sir or Madam:

Dearborn County Hospital would like to transfer control of its Byproduct Materials License, Number 13-17327-01 to Saint Elizabeth Healthcare/Saint Elizabeth Dearborn. In accordance with Appendix E of NUREG 1556, Volume 15, Revision 1, please accept the following description of the transfer of control:

1. A) St. Elizabeth Healthcare is acquiring Dearborn County Hospital with transfer of all assets to St. Elizabeth Healthcare.

B) The Board of Directors will change to the Board of Directors of St. Elizabeth Healthcare.

C) The new licensee name will be St. Elizabeth Dearborn, 600 Wilson Creek Rd., Lawrenceburg IN 47025.

D) Contact Rachel Burdette MBA, CMNT, Radiation Safety Office at the same address; (812) 537-8394.

2. There is no change in the current personnel or duties related to the licensed program.

3. There is no change in location, facilities, equipment, use, possession, or waste management. The radiation safety program will align with the policies and procedures of St. Elizabeth Healthcare and will also align with the established program of Dearborn County Hospital.

4. The current status of Dearborn County Hospitals' facilities, equipment, and radiation safety program are consistent with NRC standards and have been reviewed and vetted by a licensed Radioactive Materials physicist on a quarterly basis. There has been no known contamination and there will be no decontamination necessary prior to transfer. The current status of



calibrations, leak tests, area surveys, training, quality control, and all related records are in line with NRC standards and the policies of Dearborn County Hospital.

5. The facility is not required to have a decommissioning funding plan (DFP)
6. All records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the facility will be transferred to the transferee or to NRC, as appropriate. These records include documentation of surveys of ambient radiation levels, and fixed or removable contamination, including methods and sensitivity.
7. Both Dearborn County Hospital and St. Elizabeth Healthcare agree to the transferring of control of the licensed material and activity, the conditions of transfer. St. Elizabeth Healthcare has been made aware of any open inspection items and responsibility for possible resulting enforcement actions.
8. St. Elizabeth Healthcare will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments of Dearborn County Hospital.
