Dear Mr. Williams:

Enclosed is a copy of the proposed revisions to the Colorado Rules and Regulations Pertaining to Radiation Control, 6 CCR 1007-1, Part 16 (Radiation safety requirements for well logging and subsurface tracer studies), and Part 19 (Licenses and radiation safety requirements for irradiators). The proposed revisions have been posted for public comment through January 13, 2021. We request NRC's comments by February 15, 2021. The proposed regulations are identified by strike-out/bold text and correspond to the following equivalent amendments to NRC's regulations.

RATS ID	TITLE	STATE SECTION 6 CCR 1007-1
2020-1 (10 CFR Part 39.65)	Individual Monitoring Devices	Part 16
2020-1 (10 CFR Part 36.55)	Individual Monitoring Devices	Part 19

We believe that adoption of these revisions satisfies the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards (NMSS) Procedure SA-200, for Colorado's equivalent regulations. We recognize that the enclosed does not address changes to 10 CFR Part 34. Colorado is planning to amend its equivalent rule later in 2021.

To aid in the review of the proposed draft regulations, we have also enclosed an annotated copy of RATS 2020-1 which identifies each specific section in the proposed rules corresponding to the amended federal rule change.
