9. Authorized use.

A. For possession and storage, incidental to distribution to persons exempt from regulation, of glow switches and/or arc tubes, which are incorporated into compact fluorescent lamps, metal halide discharge lamps, and lamp starters as an aid in quick ignition. This license does not authorize commercial distribution of radioactive material. Materials will be distributed under Halco Lighting Technologies, LLC NRC license number 10-23990-01E.

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All license applications, amendments and fee payments should be mailed the same day. Annual fees are billed by the Department at the beginning of each fiscal year.

14. The licensee shall comply with the provisions of Georgia Department of Natural Resources Rule 391-3-17-.02, "Licensing of Radioactive Material. Amended.", Rule 391-3-17-.03, "Standards for Protection Against Radiation. Amended.", Rule 391-3-17-.05, "Use of Radionuclides in the Healing Arts. Amended.", Rule 391-3-17-.06, "Transportation of Radioactive Material. Amended.", Rule 391-3-17-.07, "Notice, Instructions and Reports to Workers: Inspections. Amended.", and Rule 391-3-17-.10, "Administration. Amended."
15. Notwithstanding Condition 12, licensed material shall be used by or used under the supervision of individuals who have successfully completed the manufacturer's training program or equivalent training program approved by the Department described in the renewal application dated September 30, 2015, have received copies of the licensee's operating and emergency procedures, and have been designated by the Radiation Safety Officer. Records/Certificates shall be maintained for Department inspection.
16. Sealed sources containing radioactive material shall not be opened by the licensee.
17. This license does not authorize commercial distribution of licensed material to persons exempt from licensing pursuant to (3)(b) of Rule 391-3-17-.02. Materials will be distributed under Halco Lighting Technologies, LLC NRC license number 10-23990-01E.
18. The licensee shall conduct a physical inventory every 6 months to account for all licensed material received and possessed under this license. The records of inventories shall be maintained for inspection by the Department and shall include the quantities and kinds of radioactive material, the manufacturer, the model and serial numbers if applicable, the location of radioactive material, the date of the inventory, and the name of the individual performing the inventory.
19. The licensee shall possess and use radioactive material described in Items 6, 7 and 8 of this license according to the most restrictive of the Georgia Radiation Protection Regulations; this license or statements; representations; and procedures contained in the following documents.

A. Renewal application dated August 31, 2020 and signed by Jay Weaver, CFO/RSO, Halco Lighting Technologies, LLC.

The Georgia Department of Natural Resources' Regulations shall govern unless the statements, representations and procedures in the licensee's application and correspondence are more restrictive than the Regulations.
