Background



- Annual effectiveness reviews are a part of the IMC 0307 ROP self-assessment process
- A change to the Column 3 criteria was implemented in late 2015 with corresponding changes to IP 95001
- Sufficient time has elapsed to allow for an effectiveness review of the change at this point

Review Objectives



- Scope of Review
 - Assess effectiveness of the 2015 Column 3 change and associated IP 95001 change
 - Assess pushback on White findings since 2015
 - Included in scope as a result of comments at 9/30/2020 Commission Meeting (see pages 104 and 105 of transcript in ADAMS as ML20280A819 and subject industry views in ADAMS as ML14246A465)
- Information and data considered:
 - All White Inputs since 2016
 - Bases for initial Action Matrix and the 2015 Change
 - IP 95001 inspection reports since 2016
 - Stakeholder perspectives on pushback on potentially GTG inputs

- Expect completion of review in 1Q2020
- Opportunity for external comments on Column 3 criteria and pushback on White findings at February 24, 2021 ROP public meeting
