This concerns the subject application for an amendment to your material license in accordance with your letter dated November 30, 2020. The proposed authorized user (AU) did not meet the training and experience requirements, as stated in 10 CFR 35.190, 35.290, and 35.300. Specifically, the proposed AU did not have a copy of his Board Certification and the complete documentation of the training and supervised work experience, as described in 10 CFR 35.190, *Training for uptake, dilution, and excretion studies*; 35.290, *Training for imaging and localization studies*; and the applicable sections in 35.390, *Training for use of unsealed byproduct material for which a written directive is required*.
