In accordance with the Material License SUB-526 Condition 32, Honeywell Metropolis Works (MTW) hereby submits the following information regarding the decision to resume full operations of the uranium conversion facility located in Metropolis, Illinois.

- A decision has been made by Honeywell to resume full operations at the Metropolis facility.
- Restart preparation activities will begin this year (2021) by hiring personnel for the key positions required for restart.
- Workforce hiring to be completed by the end of next year (2022).
- Honeywell anticipates a return to full production in early 2023.
