By letter dated February 28, 2020 [Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession No. ML20062C033], Virginia Electric and Power Company (Dominion Energy) responded to the February 5, 2020, Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) request for additional information (RAI) [(ADAMS) Accession No. ML20029D838] regarding the SPS SLRA Environmental Review. The RAI was related to a Conditional Concurrence finding on Dominion Energy's application for CZMA consistency certification issued by the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality (VDEQ) regarding measures to minimize impacts to fishery resources from operation of the cooling water intake at SPS.

Dominion Energy remains committed to the goal of obtaining a revised CZMA consistency determination letter from the VDEQ. As such, Dominion Energy continues to communicate with the VDEQ and the Virginia Department of Wildlife Resources (previously the Virginia Department of Game and Inland Fisheries) regularly to pursue receiving a revised CZMA consistency determination letter as soon as practical.

The purpose of this letter is to extend the update on the status of the ongoing discussions or the response to the RAI an additional 60 days from the date of this letter.

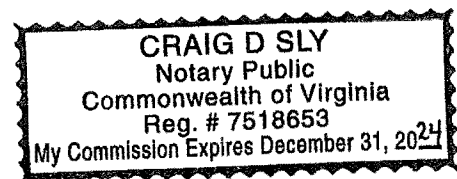
