Enclosed is a copy of proposed revisions to the Arkansas State Board of Health's Rules and Regulations for Control of Sources of Ionizing Radiation, effective October 1, 2017. At the earliest, these "July 2021" proposed revisions will be made available for public comment on approximately July 30, 2021, with a request for comments by approximately August 31, 2021. We request NRC's comments by July 19, 2021, if possible. The proposed regulations are identified by line-in/line-out text and by a right-sided border.
