Hi Kelly,

Casey Aldredge told me that you could help me dismiss Bruce's 2021 fees. Bruce had to retire effective December 31, 2020, although there were few months before that date that he didn't work either. He has [REDACTED] probably [REDACTED] that I believe, now, started as early as 2017. In late December 2019 he [REDACTED]. Since then he has [REDACTED], and by the end of 2020 he [REDACTED]

I was never fully involved with his business other than helping with the emailing of things. I asked him to find out what all he needed to do to shut down his business and retire, but it was too late; he [REDACTED]. Bruce was [REDACTED] when the packet arrived with the current invoice for fees. When he came home and opened it, he didn't know what it was for. I am trying to work through all the unfinished things, all the bills he didn't pay, balance his checkbook that he quit entering deposits and writing down checks, and trying to find all the information required by NRC to decommission his business.

One thing I can't understand is why he has had to prove his business was a Small Entity every year for over 30 years. We file income taxes every year; it should be clear as day that his business, even with our other jobs, has never made as much as \$450,000.00 in a year. He has been paying fees for two sources, too, even though he has only the Cs-137 source. He has several small check sources for

counting leak tests. I have been told they don't count as sources.

I am going to contact Russ Meyer with CRCPD about disposing of the source(s). Then I believe I have to fill out NRC FORM 314 and submit it. Should I go ahead and fill out the NRC FORM 526, Certification of Small Entity Status? It would be a life-changing hardship for me to pay all of Invoice LFB 21-3216, Docket 03032307, which was due July 1, 2021 (which makes it 41 days past due, not 60+ days). I could manage some of the small entity amount, if it was changed to one instead of two categories. Since he wants to terminate his license anyway, why should he pay anything? Are there fines for me not knowing how to dispose of his sources? Any help you can give me will be appreciated.
