Background

- August 2018 petition for rulemaking to eliminate all nonemergency event notifications
- SECY-20-0109 recommended rulemaking to:
 - Align 10 CFR 50.72(b) with safety and risk significance while taking advantage of advances in technology to improve the flow of information.
 - Reduce unnecessary reporting burden for both the NRC and licensees.
- The Commission approved the staff's recommendation to initiate rulemaking



Next Steps

- Staff Requirements Memorandum direction:
 - No Changes to Resident Inspector responsibilities
 - Consider lessons learned from Review of Administrative Requirements process
 - Discontinue if the cost of rulemaking does not justify the benefits or degrades the NRC's situational awareness
- Next steps:
 - Due May 2022: Regulatory Basis
 - o Public engagement
