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Dear Mr. Schultz:

This refers to the license amendment application dated July 15, 2021 for McLaren - Flint, NRC License No. 21-04171-04. We have reviewed the application in accordance with our [regulations](#) and NUREG-1556, Volume 9, Rev. 3, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance About Medical Use Licenses" and will need the following information.

1. The licensee requests authorization for Brian Yeh, M.D. as an authorized user (AU) for 10 CFR 35.300, including oral administration of sodium iodine I-131 (requiring a written directive for less than or equal to 33 mCi and greater than 33 mCi) and the parenteral administration of unsealed byproduct material requiring a written directive. The licensee stated that Brian Yeh, M.D. was authorized for the above in License No. 91-2898-02 issued by the City of New York. Based on our review of the referenced license (Amendment No. 5 dated September 18, 2020), Brian Yeh, M.D. was not authorized for the oral administration requiring a written directive of sodium iodine I-131 (less than or equal to 33 mCi and greater than 33 mCi). Please provide additional information that Brian Yeh, M.D. meets the requirements to be an AU for 10 CFR 35.300 for oral administration of sodium iodide I-131 as specified in 10 CFR 35.390 or 35.392 and 35.394.
2. The licensee requests to add Brooke Spencer, M.D. as an AU for 10 CFR 35.600 (limited to iridium-192 in a high dose rate (HDR) remote afterloading brachytherapy device). The licensee stated that Brooke Spencer, M.D. was listed as Brooke Trotter, M.D. in NRC License No. 21-18585-01 Amendment No. 66 dated April 9, 2019. Please provide a copy of the legal name change record.
3. Based on 10 CFR 35 and NUREG-1556, Vol. 9, Rev. 3, the proposed AU must be a physician with an active license. Please provide the medical license number with status and issuing entity (e.g., U.S. state or territory) for each proposed authorized user.

To continue review of your application, we request that you submit your response under a dated and signed cover letter within 30 days. In the cover letter, please refer the license number, docket number and Mail Control No. 627369. If you have questions, require additional time to respond, or require clarification on any of the information stated above, please contact me at 630-829-9623 or reply to this email.
