Dear Sir or Madam:

Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) letter dated January 17, 2020, transmitted approval of NRC License 41-35572-01 to Atkins Nuclear Secured (NS) with an expiration date of January 31, 2035. Atkins NS originally requested a license to handle radioactive materials in support of work planned by the company. However, Atkins NS has not invoked the conditions of the license to possess or handle radioactive materials since License 41-35572-01 was approved on January 17, 2020, and is unlikely to do so before January 17, 2022.

Since no principal activities have been, or are likely to be, conducted under License 41-35572-01 for a period of 24 months, 10 CFR 30 § 30.36 (d) (3) would nominally require Atkins NS to notify the NRC of same and expect termination of the license. However, Atkins NS considers that a continued authorization granted by the Commission to Atkins NS to retain the license pursuant to § 30.36 (f) would not represent a condition that would be detrimental to the public health and safety.

Therefore, Atkins NS is submitting this request for extension of the 24-month time specified in 10 CFR 30 § 30.36 (d) (3) for License 41-35572-01, to January 17, 2024, for consideration and approval by the NRC. Future work is expected to require handling and/or possession of radioactive materials consistent with the conditions listed in License 41-35572-01 and Atkins NS plans to use the license in proposals for this work.

Requests to extend the time periods established in paragraph (d) of 10 CFR 30 § 30.36 may be made pursuant to 10 CFR 30 § 30.36 (f), subject to approval by the Commission. If approved, and should conditions change such that License 41-35572-01 is no longer deemed needed by Atkins NS, a request for termination will be forwarded to the Commission pursuant to § 30.36 (d).
