SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF OCTOBER 21, 2021, PUBLIC MEETING TO  
DISCUSS AGENCY EFFORT TO REVIEW APPROACH TO  
ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE AND SHARE AN OVERVIEW OF  
COMMENTS PROVIDED ON THIS EFFORT TO DATE

On October 21, 2021, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a public meeting<sup>1</sup> via teleconference provide information on the NRC's systematic assessment of how the agency addresses environmental justice (EJ) in its programs, policies, and activities. The purpose of the meeting was to present feedback the NRC staff has heard to date and hear additional insights and perspectives pertaining to EJ in NRC's programs, policies, and activities. The comments and dialog provided by the meeting participants are inputs that will be used to inform the NRC staff's systematic assessment, as directed by the Commission in Staff Requirements Memorandum (SRM) M210218B.<sup>2</sup>

At the start of the meeting, the NRC staff stated that the meeting was a comment gathering meeting. As with all NRC public meetings, no regulatory decisions were made during the meeting. The NRC staff provided a short presentation<sup>3</sup> that included a summary of some of the comments and feedback that have been received to date. The NRC staff then held an extended session for public comments and questions.
