Dear Ms. Blanton:

This letter concerns your request dated August 4, 2021, to amend your U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Material License No. 10-29283-02 for Digirad Imaging Solutions, Inc. Specifically, you requested to authorize Ahmed F. Aslam, M.D. for use of Title 10 *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) 35.200 material.

In an email dated August 31, 2021, we requested additional information specific to Dr. Aslam's training and experience. To date, we have not received the requested information. Therefore, we have administratively closed the action. Please note that you may submit the information at a later date.

You will be periodically inspected by NRC. Failure to conduct your program in accordance with NRC regulations, license conditions, and representations made in your license application and supplemental correspondence with NRC will result in enforcement action against you. The NRC may issue a notice of violation, imposition of a civil penalty, or an order suspending, modifying or revoking your license as specified in the General Statement of Policy and Procedure for NRC Enforcement Actions. Since serious consequences to employees and the public can result from failure to comply with NRC requirements, prompt and vigorous enforcement action will be taken when dealing with licensees who do not achieve the necessary meticulous attention to detail and the high standard of compliance which NRC expects of its licensees.

The NRC's Safety Culture Policy Statement became effective in June 2011. While a policy statement and not a regulation, it sets forth the agency's *expectations* for individuals and organizations to establish and maintain a positive safety culture.
