Dear Colonel Neumeier:

This is to inform you that we have administratively opened a licensing action to track your decommissioning activities, because your license expired on June 30, 2021, when you did not submit a request to renew the license. Please note that, in accordance with 10 CFR 30.36(c), the license continues in effect past the expiration date for activities limited to those related to decommissioning, until the license is terminated in writing by the NRC.

We understand that you intend to terminate the license in accordance with your letter of notification dated November 10, 2020. In accordance with 10 CFR 30.36(d) and (h)(1), decommissioning is expected to be initiated immediately after notification and completed within 24 months. Therefore, we expect decommissioning to be completed no later than November 10, 2022. Based on discussions with the Radiation Safety Officer during previous licensing actions to release individual buildings, we understand that you have one remaining building to decommission prior to our terminating the license.
