Dear Mr. Deible:

In accordance with Schlumberger Technology Corporation's request dated November 22, 2021 (received November 23, 2021, current license received December 23, 2021) and R313-19-30 of the Utah Administrative Code, the licensee is hereby authorized to use radioactive materials at the temporary job sites you have specified, provided the job sites are not in areas under exclusive Federal jurisdiction. The use of radioactive materials must be conducted in accordance with the representations in Schlumberger Technology Corporation's letter, Utah and Radiation Control Rules and Schlumberger Technology Corporation's NRC radioactive material license. Following this authorization, at least three days written notification is required before engaging in any licensed activity within the State of Utah. Permission may be granted by the Director to proceed sooner in the case of undue hardship.

The Licensee should notify this office in a timely manner of any change to the information provided in the initial reciprocity request. This authorization is not effective after December 31, 2022 or 180 possession days in a calendar year, whichever occurs earlier.
