Good morning Mr. Moenster,

I have reviewed the request dated 10/5/21 to name a temporary RSO on NRC license no. 24-11128-02.

In accordance with 10 CFR 35.24(c), the licensee may name a temporary RSO for up to 60 days in a calendar year, given that the RSO is qualified. The licensee is also required to notify the NRC of the appointment of a temporary RSO (which you did in your letter dated 10/5/21).

If Dr. Amurao will serve as the RSO for more than 60 days, then I need to process this notification as an amendment and change the name of the RSO on the license. If this is the case, then I will also need a signed and dated letter transmitting the Delegation of Authority memo (see the attached document) signed and dated by the new RSO and management.

If you plan to resume the RSO responsibilities within 60 days from 10/29/21, then I do not need any additional information.
