

10 CFR 20.1802 states that the licensee shall control and maintain constant surveillance of licensed material that is in a controlled or unrestricted area and that is not in storage.

Contrary to the above, on August 25, 2021, the licensee failed to control and maintain constant surveillance of licensed material that is in a controlled or unrestricted area and that is not in storage. Specifically, on August 25, 2021, a courier delivering a package of radiopharmaceuticals left the package in small, locked metal box in the foyer of the hospital emergency room and the locked box was not secured/anchored in place and the licensee failed to maintain constant surveillance of the licensed material.

This is a Severity Level IV violation (Enforcement Policy 6.7.d)

As a corrective action the licensee anchored the delivery box, located in the emergency room foyer, to the concrete floor.
