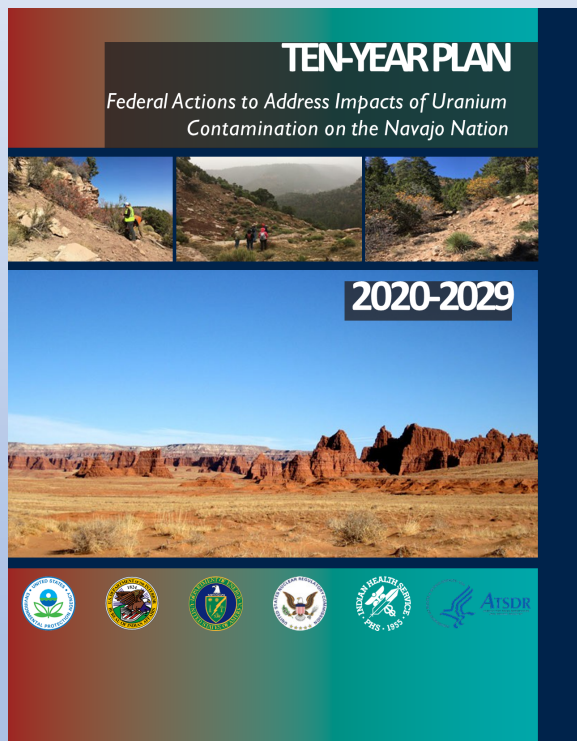

Cleanup Activities Conducted During the Investigation And Design

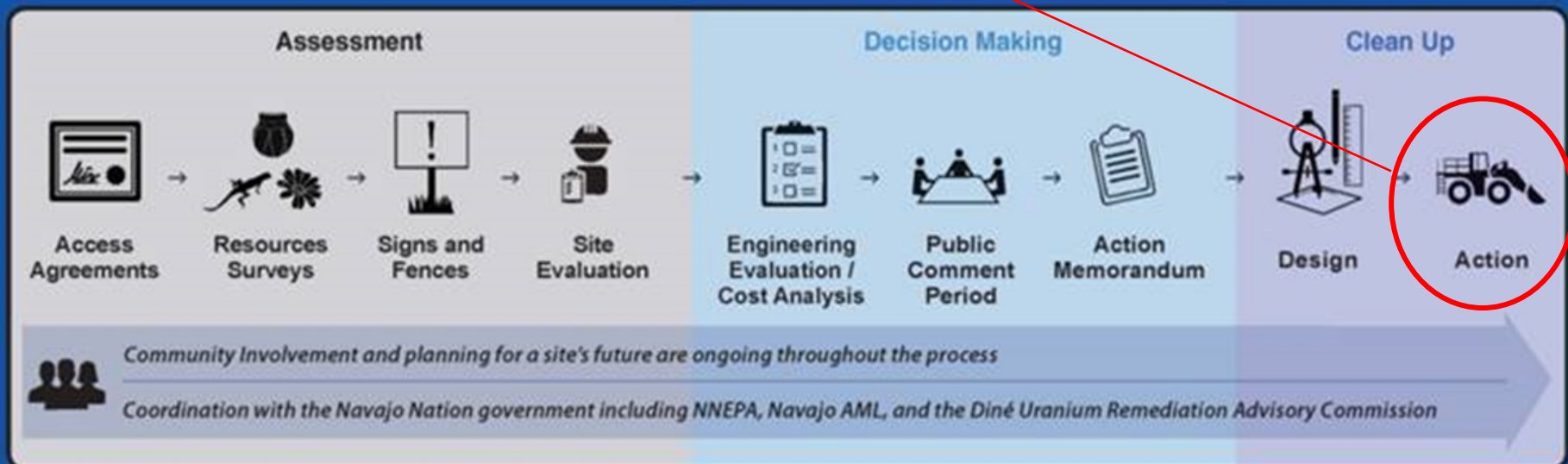




Superfund CERCLA Process

NECR is ready to move into cleanup pending NRC license decision.

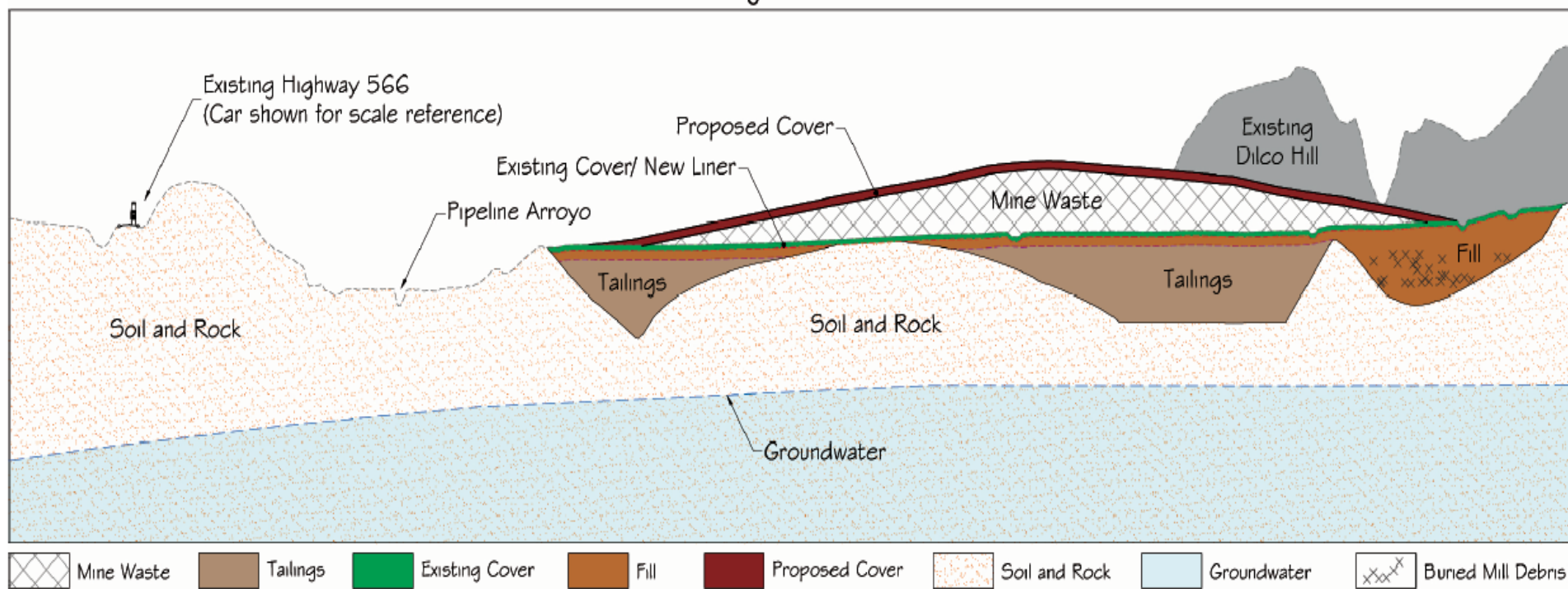
Superfund Process on the Navajo Nation

Benefits to Mine Site & UNC Mill Site



- Restore ~125 acres of NN trust land
- Reduce contamination footprint
- Improve existing UNC Mill Site cover and stormwater controls
- Provide federal long-term stewardship
- Provide jobs in local area
- Remove distinct areas of highest concentration waste to licensed repository further away from Navajo Nation
