Report of Changes to Emergency Plan

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(q)(5) and 10 CFR 72.44(f), Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) hereby submits a description of changes to the St. Lucie Radiological Emergency Plan and a summary of the analysis demonstrating that the changes do not reduce the effectiveness of the plan. The plan, as changed, continues to meet the requirements in 10 CFR 50 Appendix E and the planning standards of 10 CFR 50.47(b). The changes were incorporated in Revision 72 of the St. Lucie Radiological Emergency Plan dated April 8, 2022.

PSL Emergency Plan Revision 72 Change Summary:

- The Florida Nuclear Plant Emergency Notification Form was revised. The Licensee, State and counties agreed to the changes to the form.

The 50.54(q) evaluation determined that there is no decrease in effectiveness of the Emergency Plan due to the changes.
