Curtiss-Wright Corporation ("Curtiss-Wright"), a Delaware corporation, on behalf of its subsidiary, Curtiss-Wright Electro-Mechanical Corporation, hereby requests expedited processing of its Minor Amendment Application to NRC License XR172/05 (submitted April 20, 2022) to update Block 8a to clarify the role for Intermediate Foreign Consignee, Shanghai Electrical Nuclear Power Equipment Company Ltd. (SENPEC) as a purchasing agent of spare parts and components. Curtiss-Wright has placed a hold on the delivery of Nozzle Dam Diaphragm Seals pending NRC's approval of the Minor Amendment.

Plant Name and Location: Sanmen Nuclear Power Plant, Units 1-2
Contractual Delivery Date: January 22, 2022
Plant Scheduled for Outage: May 10, 2022

In addition, open-source media reports (see attached) indicate that the PRC government has approved additional construction projects including Sanmen Nuclear Power Plant Units 3 and 4 and Haiyang Nuclear Power Plant Units 3 and 4, which are CAP1000 plants using Westinghouse transferred AP1000 technology. Therefore, failing to meet the customer's outage need will jeopardize our competitive position in China.

We respectfully request NRC's expedited processing of the above-referenced Minor Amendment in order to meet the customer's outage date.
