Enclosed is an application XR172/06, dated April 25, 2022, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) from Curtiss-Wright Electro-Mechanical Corporation. The purpose of the amendment is to update the role of an Intermediate Foreign Consignee #12 as listed on their current active license XR172/05. The licensee is authorized to export and oversee exports by parties of various NRC-controlled primary reactor coolant pump-related commodities used to manufacture complete primary coolant pumps system, related equipment, and spare parts for installation at the Sanmen and Haiyang Nuclear Power Plants, and the AP1000 testing facility at Shenyang, China.

The applicant has requested an expedited review of their requested change, as they have a pending shipment. The NRC will grant their request to expedite this review. There are no changes to the terms and conditions of the existing license being requested. Therefore, our office is processing this as a minor amendment.
