Dear Dr. Krugh:

In application dated November 23, 2021, you notified the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) of a request to terminate NRC Materials License No. 21-26562-01. Your application is available electronically from the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at Accession No. ML21328A231 (non-public).

In your letter dated July 6, 2022, you submitted additional information sufficient to permit the transfer of facilities at 730 N Macomb St., Monroe, Michigan, to another NRC licensee — Mercy Memorial Hospital, NRC License No. 21-18816-01. Based on its review, the NRC staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material at 730 N Macomb St., Monroe, Michigan has been transferred from The Toledo Hospital Cardiac Testing Center Monroe, NRC License No. 21-26562-01, to Mercy Memorial Hospital, NRC License No. 21-18816-01.

Based on this conclusion, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC-regulated material are required on the part of The Toledo Hospital Cardiac Testing Center Monroe. The NRC understands that all records concerning the safe and effective decommissioning of the 730 N Macomb St., Monroe, Michigan facility have been transferred to and will be maintained by Mercy Memorial Hospital, NRC License No. 21-18816-01.

Accordingly, NRC License No. 21-26562-01 is hereby terminated. A copy of the amended license—Amendment No. 14—is enclosed.

An environmental assessment for this action is not required because this action is categorically excluded under Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (CFR) Section 51.22(c).
