Shortly after (approximately 4-5 minutes later), the Philadelphia Airport Tower [DELETED] called and advised the Team Leader that a Cessna fixed wing aircraft, Tail # N410BS, will be flying over the site to take photographs. The tower could provide no further information regarding ownership of the aircraft or who is taking the photographs. PSEG Nuclear (Salem/Hope Creek Station) had no prior knowledge of the fly-over, nor was it authorized.

"Consequently, we contacted the Philadelphia FAA Flight Standards Office [DELETED], who identified the owner of the aircraft and the location of the airport where the flight originated. The plane originated from the Millville Airport and is owned by Big Sky Aviation, 103 Leddon Dr., Millville, NJ 08332, Tel# (800) 752-9207 [DELETED].
