This refers to your letter dated May 26, 2022 requesting an amendment to NRC License No. 47-15501-01. In order for us to continue our review please provide the following additional information:

1. NRC Form 313A (RSO) lists the supervising individual as Dr. Dimitri Misailidis and License No. 47-15501-01 issued to University Healthcare – Berkeley Medical Center, Inc. Please confirm Dr. Misailidis was the Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) on the license prior to Chad Mitchel, Ph.D. being named in Amendment 34 (issued April 18, 2022) and the supervision provided to Dr. Padha documented in Section 5.C. of the NRC Form 313A (RSO) was during that time (i.e. in accordance with 10 CFR 35.59).

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. Your reply must be an originally signed and dated letter. The letter may be scanned and submitted as a pdf document attached to an email (preferred option); or it may be transmitted by facsimile to (610) 337-5269; or it may be sent by regular mail.

Please note that the Region I office is currently in the process of moving to 475 Allendale Road, King of Prussia, PA 19406, with the official move date to be determined. In order to continue prompt review of your application, we request that you submit your response to this letter within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter.
