General Comment

We live within 10 miles of the Indian Point nuclear power plant that is currently being decommissioned. We feel strongly that rules must be maintained to ensure that we never risk being exposed to an accidental or intentional (e.g. corporate shortcuts, terrorism) radioactive release.
