On May 10, 2021, EnergySolutions, LLC (ES) and Dominion Energy Kewaunee, Inc. (DEK) (collectively, the Applicants) submitted a license transfer application (LTA) for the Kewaunee Power Station (KPS) (Accession No. ML21131A141). The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) approved the transfer of License No. DPR-43 for the KPS by order dated March 31, 2022 (the Order, Accession No. ML22014A392). The NRC issued the Conforming License Amendment regarding indirect transfer of the License from Dominion Energy Kewaunee, Inc. to Kewaunee Solutions, Inc. on June 28, 2022 (Accession No. ML22160A526) and attached Amendment No. 11 to Indemnity Agreement No. B-53 (the Agreement, Accession No. ML22160A527).

The purpose of this letter is to provide a signed copy of Amendment No. 11 to Indemnity Agreement No. B-53 as requested in the Conforming License Amendment regarding indirect transfer of the License from Dominion Energy Kewaunee, Inc. to Kewaunee Solutions, Inc., and serves as proof of Kewaunee Solutions' acceptance of the Agreement.

AMENDMENT NO. 11


In light of the above, Indemnity Agreement No. B-53 is between "Kewaunee Solutions, Inc." and the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission.
