I very much appreciate the assistance from Randy Ragland in finding another contact, because the DHS website, and the DHS Operator number, were unhelpful in finding any contact for CWMD. In fact, one of the DHS operators with whom I spoke, said he had never heard of CWMD.

Please confirm if I understand what you are requesting in the application signed May 31, 2022, with the attachment dated April 19, 2022:

- Please provide contact information for Thomas Costeira – phone number and email address. there was no 313A attached for Thomas Costeira, but it is not necessary as the 313A is applicable only to medical licenses under 10 CFR Part 35.

- The associate Radiation Safety Officer is a position established only in 10 CFR Part 35, and is not used on non-medical licenses. Confirm if you wish this individual added as an authorized user.

- Please provide documentation of training and experience in the types, forms and quantities of materials authorized on your license. The form 313A documents only the experience handling medical radionuclides under Part 35. The information in Part 1, Section 3 is acceptable for training in radiation safety.
